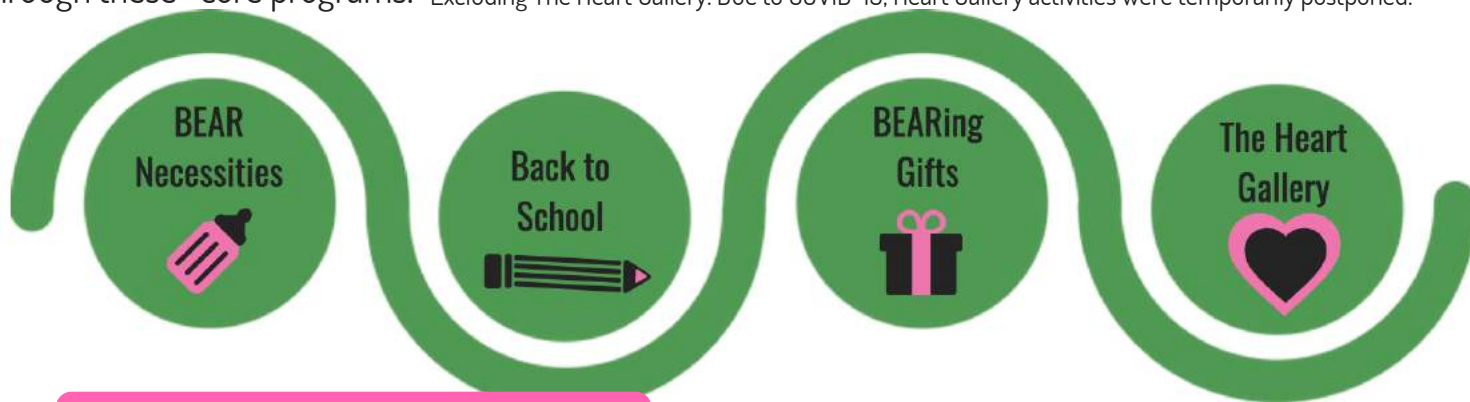

2. Fully Operational During COVID-19

Deemed an essential business allowed to remain open in March of 2020, BEAR remained FULLY OPERATIONAL throughout COVID-19 related business closures. With many families out of work and/or having trouble locating basic necessities for their children, BEAR continue to address not only the everyday needs of children in CPS care, but also the additional emergency need brought forth by the pandemic. BEAR provided resources for 15,952 children between October 1, 2019 - September 30th, 2020.

3. Diverse Resource Options

BEAR's programs are designed to better support thousands of deserving children across the Greater Houston Area. In the 2020 fiscal year, BEAR provided over **34,500 services** to children under the supervision of CPS through these *core programs. *Excluding The Heart Gallery. Due to COVID-19, Heart Gallery activities were temporarily postponed.



4. The NEED



At any given moment, there are **16,000** children are under the supervision of Child Protective Services. **Over 1,000** of these children are removed from their homes under emergency conditions. Through the BEAR Necessities program, BEAR provides these children with immediate resources, and the help they need to feel hopeful for a brighter tomorrow.
