As BEAR closes out its fiscal year, I would like to say thank you on behalf of myself, the staff, and the Board of Directors for another remarkable year. To those, I have met and to those, I haven't had the opportunity to meet yet, I would like to thank you for the contributions you have made to BEAR and the children and families we have served over the year. From monetary and gift donations to volunteer hours and beyond, we have been able to collectively serve the most children in BEAR's history. This is important as children and families continue to experience hardships at unprecedented rates and are in need of resources more than ever.



I would like to take a moment to highlight BEAR's success with Heart Gallery Houston. In October 2021, BEAR began displaying Heart Gallery Houston photographic exhibits throughout the Greater Houston area to educate and spread awareness to the thousands of children in the foster care system. With the help of a handful of amazing volunteer photographers, BEAR has been able to take beautiful photographs of children currently in foster care waiting for a "Forever Family" and exhibit them through our community. By the end of this calendar year, Heart Gallery Houston will be in 5 of our local shopping malls but has also been exhibited in the Children's Museum, a few Houston Astros' Games, two YMCA's, local art exhibits, shopping events, and more. To date, 26 children featured in Heart Gallery Houston have found "Forever Families". It is thanks to YOUR support that we are able to provide programming such as Heart Gallery Houston to the children we serve on a daily, weekly, and yearly basis.

Also, because of your support BEAR was able to serve over

38,000 children through our BEAR Necessities Program, over 11,500 children through our Back to School Program, and finally, over 19,500 children through our BEARing Gifts Program. Your continued belief in our work means more children will be comforted during oftentimes very traumatic times of their lives.

We can change the trajectory of their lives through the Heart Gallery photography and hopefully gift them with their forever families.


What's your favorite thing about being a mom?
